



Curriculum for A2.2 Advanced Beginning German 2

Materials: *Schritte International Neu 3+4*, Chapter 5–9; *Kursbuch* (textbook), *Arbeitsbuch* (workbook)

Course Content

Structurally: Students will continue to expand and practice structures they have learned so far. In this course, adjective endings will be introduced. Students will explore prepositions to indicate phrases of time or place. By adding subordinate clauses, or connecting clauses, sentences will become increasingly complex. Pronunciation practice will focus on individual sounds and more challenging words.

Functionally: Students will continue to expand their vocabulary to talk about topics of personal interest, including jobs and travel. They will learn to express opinions and emotions in written texts and conversations and to interpret statistics and radio reports. They will also learn to thank someone and offer congratulations.

Objectives

At the end of A 2.2, students will be able to talk about their personal lives and offer some details about their education and career as well as their hopes and dreams. They can interact in a simple way—provided the other person talks slowly and clearly and is prepared to help. They can make phone calls and take messages.
