



Curriculum for B1.1 Intermediate German 1

Materials: *Schritte International Neu 5+6*, Chapter 1–5; *Kursbuch* (textbook), *Arbeitsbuch* (workbook)

Course Content

Structurally: B 1.1 is the first course of the Intermediate German sequence. Students will reinforce and practice their basic German skills and continue to expand them. Students will continue to work with prepositions and begin to study the genitive case and its specific prepositions. They will also learn to build increasingly complex sentence constructions using a variety of conjunctions and subordinate clauses. Students will also learn the simple past, the past perfect, subjunctive and the passive voice.

Functionally: Students will begin to express an opinion and offer reasons for their decisions as well as to write commentaries. They will learn to order information chronologically using past and past perfect tenses. They will be able to book a trip in a travel agency, talk about purchases and complain about faulty products.
