



Curriculum for B1.3 Intermediate German 3

Materials: *Schritte International Neu 5+6*, Chapter 11–14; *Kursbuch* (textbook), *Arbeitsbuch* (workbook)

Course Content

Structurally: B 1.3 continues the Intermediate German sequence. Students will reinforce and practice their basic German skills and finish the basic grammar by learning past perfect in the passive voice and the future tense.

Functionally: Students will learn to conduct arguments and speak about conflicts. They can offer and accept help and understand and discuss songs. They learn how to modify statements and read expressively.

Objectives

At the end of B 1.3 students will be able to understand and express chronological order. They know how to describe people, images and objects in detail and express emotions. They will be able to talk about German historical events and evaluate them. They will also be able to discuss problems and opinions and they know how to find information in reports, chats and articles.
