- > Heidelberg University, the oldest university in Germany, was founded in 1386 and is also the sixth-oldest university in Europe. The university has a long tradition as a research university and has produced more than 30 Nobel prize laureates.
- > Many German universities include a free transportation card with the tuition, so students can ride local and regional public transportation for free during their studies.
