9:30 AM-Reception at the Chamber of Commerce with refreshments and treats

10:15 AM-12:15 PM-New Ulm sightseeing by bus

Sights include the Hermann Monument, Cathedral of the Holy Trinity (a great example of German Baroque architecture), German Park and the German Bohemian Immigrant monument, Heritage Tee, Lind house, Steamboat Landing, Glockenspiel (at noon), the Grand Center for Arts and Culture, downtown architecture, Dakota War sites and Defenders monument.

<u>12:15–1:30 PM</u>–Lunch at the historic Turner Hall Learn about the Turner history and more about the founding of New Ulm. *Menu:* German Plate—brat, sauerkraut, German potato salad, and rye bread.

<u>1:45 PM</u>—Tour the Wanda Gag House. Wanda Gag is the author and illustrator of *Millions of Cats*, a children's literature classic written in 1928.

<u>2:30 PM</u>—Shop downtown New Ulm or see the exhibit at the Grand Center for Arts and Culture

3:30 PM-Brewery tour and beer tasting at Schell's Brewery

5:00-6:00 PM-Travel to Minnesota's Largest Candy Store in Jordan, Minnesota

<u>6:45–7:00 PM</u>–Dinner at the Jordan Supper Club *Menu:* House salad, goat cheese toast, slow-roasted sirloin with wild mushroom
