



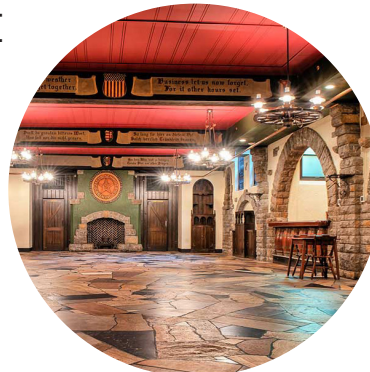
Join us for dinner and a show to celebrate community and support the GAI

Filmkurs

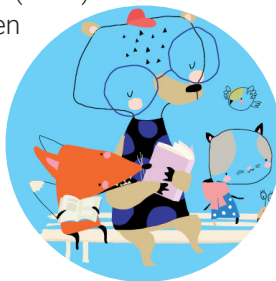
C1 Filmkurs: Der Zweite Weltkrieg, die DDR, und Träume und Talent
