Food Vendor Details

- Vendors will receive space for (1) Food truck or 10x20 space (please indicate)
- Vendors will provide their own tent, display, lights, signage, and any needed booth items.
- Vendor fee includes electricity. Those requiring electricity must provide a detailed explanation of their power needs with their vendor application (How many of each amp circuit they will need, if they need special adapters). The GAI is not responsible for power outages.
- Vendors agree to use ONLY COMPOSTABLE SERVICEWARE including, but not limited to, plates, cups, to-go containers and utensils. No single-use plastics or styrofoam are allowed.
- No beverages, including water, soda, or alcohol may be sold by food vendors.
- **Cost: \$750 for both days, all necessary forms and payment in full is due by May 2, 2025.**
